
Question:

Have changing donor acceptance criteria led to changes in the number of kidney-only and liver-only donors over time?


Answer:

Yes. In the late 80's and early 90's there were a significant number of kidney only donors. Now that number has decreased, but there has also been an increase in the number of liver-only donors. Generally, these are very old donors (age > 70) when only the liver is recovered.


Organs Recovered from Deceased Donors U.S.




Organs Recovered from Deceased Donors Region 1
















